PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, March 4, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Wednesday, March 4, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 6.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 6.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will increase by 9.0 cpl; and
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 8.0 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 154.2 to 155.4 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 164.6 to 165.7 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 203.9 to 205.0 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 145.1 cpl.

Pricing adjustments outside of the scheduled weekly adjustment, otherwise known as interruptions, are sometimes required to respond to market conditions and ensure that petroleum prices are fair for consumers and wholesalers/retailers. Global markets are currently experiencing high volatility in response to geopolitical tensions abroad. As markets continue to respond to global events, the Commission has had to respond with appropriate pricing adjustments to maintain fairness for Islanders and consistent supply.
