PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, March 31, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Tuesday March 31, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 7.1 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 6.7 cpl;
- The price of diesel will increase by 12.0 cpl; and
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 12.0 cpl;

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 194.8 to 196.0 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 205.7 to 206.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 256.3 to 257.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 193.3 cpl.

The Commission would like to advise consumers that escalation of geopolitical conflicts has resulted in market volatility and steep price increases over the weekend. The Commission continues to monitor these conditions daily to ensure that prices are fair for consumers and wholesalers/retailers and that consistent supply is available across the province.

The Commission's next scheduled pricing adjustment is Friday, April 3, 2026.
