PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 3, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, April 3, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will increase by 3.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will increase by 3.5 cpl;
- There will be no change in the price of diesel;
- There will be no change in the price of furnace oil; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 1.9 cpl for Irving Energy, decrease by 1.4 cpl for Superior Propane, no change in the price for Avenir Energy, a decrease by 3.9 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and a decrease by 3.9 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 198.3 to 199.4 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 209.8 to 210.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 256.3 to 257.5 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 193.3 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 94.3 to 96.5 cpl.

The Commission wishes to advise consumers that, due to the holiday on Monday, there will be no scheduled pricing adjustment on Tuesday, April 7, 2026.
