PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 17, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Friday, April 17, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 3.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 3.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 11.0 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 11.0 cpl; and
- Propane prices will decrease by 5.7 cpl for Irving Energy, decrease by 5.5 cpl for Superior Propane, decrease by 3.0 cpl for Avenir Energy, decrease by 7.7 cpl for Kenmac Energy Inc. and a decrease by 7.7 cpl for Noonan Petroleum.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 186.8 to 187.9 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 198.3 to 199.4 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 224.1 to 225.3 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 163.9 cpl.

Propane prices will range from 88.5 to 92.9 cpl.
