## NOTICE

### PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, April 21, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Tuesday, April 21, 2026:

- There will be no change in the price of regular gasoline;
- There will be no change in the price of premium gasoline;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 4.0 cents per litre (cpl); and
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 2.0 cpl.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 175.3 to 176.4 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 186.8 to 187.9 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 214.9 to 216.1 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 161.8 cpl.

The Commission would like to advise consumers that market conditions remain fluid with the state of global conflicts. The Commission continues to monitor these conditions daily to ensure that prices are fair for consumers and wholesalers/retailers and that consistent supply is available across the province.
