PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, June 23, 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Tuesday, June 23, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will not change;
- The price of premium gasoline will not change;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.5 cpl;
- The price of furnace oil will decrease by 3.0 cpl; and

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 177.6 to 178.7 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 187.9 to 189.1 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 200.0 to 201.1 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 142.9 cpl before applicable tax.

The Commission would like to advise consumers that the market remains volatile. The Commission would also like to remind consumers that the market price is not the only factor that must be considered by the Commission when setting the price of gasoline each week. The Commission must also consider things like year-to-date margins, averages, and the general trends of market prices. These factors are reflected in the price that is set.

The Commission is including a chart showing the year-over-year comparison of fuel prices, including a comparison between the price of Brent Crude this time last year.
