PETROLEUM PRICING

Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, August 4th 2026 – The Prince Edward Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission approved the following petroleum prices effective 12:01 a.m., Tuesday, August 4, 2026:

- The price of regular gasoline will decrease by 6.0 cents per litre (cpl);
- The price of premium gasoline will decrease by 6.0 cpl;
- The price of diesel will decrease by 1.0; and
- The price of furnace oil will increase by 3.0 cpl.

Including taxes, pump prices for regular unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 193.7 to 194.8 cpl, prices for premium unleaded gasoline at self-serve outlets will range from 205.2 to 206.3 cpl and prices for diesel will range from 243.1 to 244.3 cpl.

The maximum price for furnace oil is 173.6 cpl before applicable taxes.

The Commission would like to advise consumers that the market remains volatile. The Commission would also like to remind consumers that the market price is not the only factor that must be considered by the Commission when setting the price of gasoline each week. The Commission must also consider things like year-to-date margins, averages, and the general trends of market prices. These factors are reflected in the price that is set.

The Commission is including a chart showing the year-over-year comparison of fuel prices, including a comparison between the price of Brent Crude this time last year.
